

Young Musical Talent Contest 2023



The Department of Culture and the Municipal School of Music and Dance have convened the fourth edition of the Young Musical Talents Contest 2023 with the aim of promoting musical activity, culture and art created by young musicians from Nerja and Maro. The event will be held on May 19th and 20th at the Villa de Nerja Cultural Centre.

All young people between the ages of 8 and 21 may participate. The deadline for submitting applications will remain open until next Friday, May 5th. Three categories have been established: initiation level, from 8 to 10 years old, with prizes ranging between 180 and 80 euros; medium level, from 11 to 14 years old, with prizes between 250 and 130 euros; and professional level, from 12 to 21 years old, with prizes from 280 to 180 euros. In addition, the Jovenes Valores Award is awarded, endowed with 150 euros.

The contest has the collaboration of the companies and entities Maremusic RBC SL, Pianos Francis, AMPA Santa Cecilia and the Nerja Hispanic-Nordic Association.



San Isidro Pilgrimage 15th May contest

An important part of the San Isidro festival is the horsemen, horse-drawn carriages, ox carts and mechanically-tracted floats. The City Council wants to recognize and reward the work of the residents for maintaining this tradition. San Isidro 2023 bar selection

From April 24th until May 4th at 12 noon, applications can be made for San Isidro 2023, bar stands. Associations and groups that are duly registered in the

Municipal Registry of Associations of Nerja may participate and must be carried out through the Municipal Electronic Office. Elena Gálvez has detailed that a total of ten bars will be drawn, "seven of them intended to serve drinks and three may also offer food service.

City Council will increase the Local Police by nine new officers

Nerja will increase the Local Police with nine new officers. The Governing Board has approved the appointment of five of them as trainee officials, at the proposal of the Selection Board, after the completion of the selection process. These new police officers will begin the entry course at the Institute of Emergencies and Public Security of Andalusia (IESPA), where they will receive specialized training according to their new police work.

Drug trafficker Piolín arrested on the Costa del Sol

The trafficker, one of the most wanted, leads one of the two large gangs also dedicated to human trafficking and extortion in Ceuta. The detainee had, according to the police, up to 70 people under his orders, and was armed at the time of his arrest.

Anselmo Sevillano, one of the great hashish drug traffickers arrested in Estepona

The drug trafficker Anselmo Sevillano has been arrested in Estepona by local police officers from that municipality and Marbella after a chase along the A-7 motorway and the housing developments in the area. Considered one of the most active hashish drug traffickers at the turn of the century, he had been arrested in Huelva in 2011 after six years on the run from justice.

Body of man found near road that leads to popular Nerja beach

The corpse of a man was found near a road that leads to Maro beach. An autopsy revealed signs that he had been beaten and suffered a blow to his head. Guardia Civil officers are investigating the death of a middle-aged Czech man whose body was found on March 27th near Maro beach, Nerja. The case is being treated as homicide as a forensic examination of the body showed signs that the man had been beaten and had a hole in his head. The body was taken to the Axarquía hospital in Torre del Mar.

Malaga Airport during the first quarter of 2023 had the third highest number of passengers in Spain The number of passengers was 35.4 per cent more than last year. As a result, it placed third overall in Spain.

San Pedro chiringuito destroyed by fire

Local Police and the Fire Brigade arrived at the Playa Nini Restaurant and Beach Club to the sight of a raging inferno. No reports of any injuries but the chiringuito building was totally destroyed and the cause of the fire is now being investigated.

100 free training courses for young people

The courses offered are related to office automation, first aid, nutrition and dietetics, food handler, mechanics, languages, accounting and human resources, among others.

Tests to obtain the Municipal Certificate of Aptitude for taxi driver. The Councillor for Security and Transportation, Francisco Arce, reports that the exam will take place next Thursday, May 18th at 11 am at the Villa de Nerja Cultural Center. Applications must be submitted by May 5th at the City Hall Entry Register or by Electronic Office.

Torrox Park will soon have its Green Park

The Torrox City Council continues to provide the municipality with new green areas and recreation areas. On this occasion, the mayor of the municipality, Óscar Medina, and the Councillor for Procurement, Paula Moreno, have announced that works will begin shortly for the creation of the Green Park in Torrox Park. Medina wanted to highlight that among the priorities of the government team was "that the children who go to the El Faro school in Torrox Park, a district with an increasingly larger population, have a recreation area in the afternoon, as do the neighbours of Los Llanos or Mare Nostrum". For her part, the Councillor for Procurement detailed that Torrox Park will have landscaped areas, lots of vegetation, pergolas, paths for both walking and cycling, as well as its own play area for the little ones. It is a plot with a total area of 3,048 m2 and work will be carried out practically in the entire area, 3,013 m2, leaving 2,849 m2 of usable area,

Medina to create five new underground car parks distributed throughout the municipality

Torrox has exceeded 20,000 inhabitants according to the official National Institute of Statistics as of January 1st 2023. It is clear that it is necessary to be prepared for the spectacular growth of Torrox-.

The first municipal authority has commissioned drafting projects for five new underground car parks with which the town will have a total of eight.

I didn't see any locusts, but the frog in the little pond seems to have invited all his mates in for a croak together, as the noise during the evening has been almost deafening. It's interesting though how one gets used to natural

noises, as it doesn't seem to stop us from falling asleep, even though the pond is only a few steps away from our bedroom window.

From reports in the local press, it should have rained in February. Farmers had reported that they could lose 15% of the first spring crops if something didn't happen soon! It did, so much so, that the water authorities had to offload the excess into the rivers!

April-Late

Over the past few weeks, I have gradually been clearing the sunken garden of tough weeds and grasses and stones, ready

for sowing wild flower seeds. Well, I cleared it as far as my energy levels let me on a warm, still sunny day, down I went with a mix of 'Flores Silvestres' in a large plastic wallet and I scattered them all around. I had already marked pathways out with canes so that I can walk through what I hope to be a mass of colour and 'landing pads' for all the visiting butterflies. To scramble up the walls, I planted Ipomoeas in blues and pinks and a cutting of honeysuckle. With all this rain, there is already a 'fuzz' of green over the bare soil and with the help of some more sun,

perhaps it will not be too I ong before it is all 'a-bloom!' It was easy to find wild seed collections out here. Most of the viveros have them including the larger DIY stores in Málaga.

The last packets I bought which were by Bricobi actually listed the flower types. They range from Achilleas to Dianthus, Alyssum to Gypsophilia, Lavender, Poppies and many more.

The photograph on the front of the packet is beautiful and I am hoping for the same effect. The perennial shrubs are all flourishing. The Heliotropium was quite a small plant last year when first planted. It is now three times the size with a mass of vanilla scented lavender coloured flowers. In the same flower bed is one of the easiest to grow perennials that I first discovered in England. It is called Coreopsis; my variety is 'Early Sunrise'. A spreading and clump forming plant, with semi-double bright yellow blooms and it flowers in the first year, always a plus when planting perennials. You 'dead head' regularly for continuous show throughout the summer. It is a lovely cut flower.

DOG SCHOOL - NERJA 5 Golden Rules of Dog Training



Training your dog should be fun, especially if you do it right. It also provides your dog with a lot of benefits like mental stimulation and learning proper etiquette and discipline. It's a good idea to keep these 5 Golden Rules in mind when you start training your dog

#1. GET TO KNOW YOUR DOG

Every dog has a different temperament, learning style, and drive for certain things. One dog might have a hard time picking up new tricks, while another has no problem at all. With this in mind, you need to pay extra attention to your dog's needs and learning characteristics. **#2. MAKE IT AN ENJOYABLE**

EXPERIENCE

Just like in teaching young children, you need to keep dog training sessions fun. You can use treats, verbal praise, or even belly rubs to reward your dog. We all remember things that we enjoy doing, and want to do it again; the same applies to your dog!

#3. CONSISTENCY IS VITAL TO YOUR TRAINING SUCCESS

Consistency matters a lot in training your dog. For example, if you're going to teach your dog how to sit, make sure to



stick with the same verbal or physical cues. Otherwise, you end up confusing him/her. It's also helpful to maintain a schedule, especially for feeding, playing, and walking. It helps create that routine that will guide them every single day. Another way you can maintain consistency is to keep everyone in your family up to date on the training progress. More importantly, they have to know the rules you're trying to set for the dogs, otherwise they could undo all your hard work!

#4. LEARN WHEN TO CALL IT A DAY Dogs get tired too! Eventually, when attention span lapses, they no longer feel interested in listening to you or following your instructions.

While it's tempting to keep each training session longer, you need to keep it brief each day to ensure that you don't

overwhelm your dog. Ideally, each lesson should last no more than 15 to 20 minutes each day. Give your dog ample time to rest. To reinforce what you taught him/her, you'll need to repeat the routine each day.

#5. AVOID PUNISHING YOUR DOG AT ALL COSTS!

Punishing your dog won't teach them anything, nor will it improve their behaviour. It can turn even the most wellmannered dog into an aggressive one. Instead of resorting to punishment, use positive reinforcement to teach your dog. Encourage them through verbal or physical cues. You can say "good boy!" or "Yes!" to show your approval. Training doesn't always have to involve food as the reward - find out what really motivates your dog the most and reward them often! 





Seafood Paella

Seafood Paella

Serves:-6

Ingredients:-

3 tablespoons (42 ml) olive oil

 $6 \mbox{ ounces}$ (170 g) dried chorizo sausage , sliced, and cut into half moons

1 tablespoon (8 g) garlic , minced

- 1 medium yellow onion, diced, about 1 cup
- 1 medium bell pepper, 1/2 sliced, 3/4 -1 cup



- 1 teaspoon (1 g) thyme , diced
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 teaspoon (2 g) smoked paprika
- salt and pepper

 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup (117.5 ml) dry white wine

- 15 oz (425 g) crushed tomatoes
- 2 ³/₄ cups (687 ml) seafood broth or water
- 1 ½ cups (295.5 g) arborio rice
- ¹/₂ teaspoon saffron threads
- ³/₄ cup (120 g) frozen peas,, thawed
- 1 pound (453 g) large shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 1/2 pound (226 g) black mussels
- 2 tablespoons (8 g) chopped flat-leaf parsley 1 lemon, sliced
- Preparation:-

Heat 3 tablespoons oil in a large cast iron skillet or paella pan over medium high heat, add chorizo and sauté until browned, about 4 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, remove and set aside; leaving juices in pan.

Add in garlic, onion, red bell pepper, thyme, bay leaf, smoked paprika, pinch of salt & pepper. Sauté for 3 - 4 minutes until onions and peppers start to soften. Add in white wine and allow liquid to evaporate, about 1 - 2 minutes.

Add in the can of crushed tomatoes and seafood broth. Bring to a boil and add the rice and saffron threads. Stir the rice to combine, then lower heat to low and cover for 15 minutes. This achieves a crispy bottom layer. Add in the chorizo back in along with the thawed peas and stir. Then add the seafood on top, with the opening of the mussels facing up so they can open. Cover and cook for an additional 10 minutes then flip shrimp and cook for an additional 5 - 10 minutes. Shrimp should be pink and mussels should open.

Remove from heat, top with parsley, serve with fresh lemon slices.



New Potato Salad

New potato salad

Serves:- 6

Ingredients:-

750g new potatoes 1 tbsp nigella seeds 200ml tub of Greek yogurt 150g radishes, thinly sliced good handful of fresh dill, chopped

Preparation:-

Put the potatoes in a pan of cold salted water, bring to the boil, then simmer for 12 minutes or until tender. Drain, then cut any large potatoes in half. Heat a non-stick frying pan, add the nigella seeds and dry-fry for 30 seconds or so until they start to crackle. Remove from the heat. Put in a large bowl with the Greek yogurt and some seasoning. Mix in the warm potatoes, coating well, then toss through the radishes and most of the dill. Sprinkle over a little more chopped dill, then serve.



Spanish Style Cod and Chickpea Stew Spanish-style cod and chickpea stew

Serves:-4

Ingredients:-

100g diced chorizo 1 sliced onion 2 sliced garlic cloves 1 tsp smoked paprika 1 tbsp tomato purée 250ml vegetable stock 400g tin of drained and rinsed chickpeas 2 sliced roasted red peppers from a jar 500g cod loin Chopped fresh flatleaf parsley Crusty bread or rice, to serve

Preparation:-

Heat a large non-stick pan, then fry the chorizo and onion for 8 minutes or until soft and caramelised. Add the garlic cloves and smoked paprika and cook for 1 minute. Stir in the tomato purée, vegetable stock, chickpeas and roasted red peppers. Cook for 4-5 minutes until thickened. Cut the cod loin into 4cm chunks, then nestle into the sauce. Cook for 3-5 minutes or until cooked through and the fish flakes easily. Sprinkle with chopped fresh flatleaf parsley and serve with crusty bread or rice.

Pasta with pea pesto

Serves:-4

Ingredients:-400g shelled peas 350g fusilli, or similar Small handful rocket A few fresh mint leaves 1 garlic clove 15g blanched almonds

15g grated parmesan or vegetarian alternative, plus extra to serve 50ml extra-virgin olive oil

2 tbsp crème fraiche Large handful pea shoots

Preparation:-

Cook the peas in boiling water for 2-3 minutes, drain and refresh under cold water.

Cook the pasta in boiling salted water for 10-12 minutes until al dente. Drain, reserving a little cooking water. Return to the pan along with the water.

Meanwhile, in a food processor, whizz two-thirds of the peas with the rocket, mint, garlic, almonds and parmesan. Season, then gradually drizzle in the oil, whizzing to a thick pesto. Add the crème fraîche and a little of the reserved cooking water to loosen.

Stir the pesto through the hot pasta. Add the remaining peas and the pea shoots. Season, then divide among bowls and serve with extra parmesan.



Acupuncture combats menopausal hot flashes

Acupuncture Treatments Help Women Manage Menopause Symptoms

Acupuncture has been used in traditional Chinese medicine for thousands of years to combat different health problems such as nausea, headaches, asthma or osteoarthritis, among others, but now a meta-analysis of the North American Menopause Society (NAMS, in its acronym in English)) has shown that it can also be used to alleviate hot flashes in women with menopause.

This is clear from the results of a work that will be published soon in the edition of the journal

'Menopause', which analyzed more than one hundred studies that evaluated this method, of which only 12, with a total of 869 participants, met the Established criteria to prove its effectiveness.

In this way, and despite the fact that its benefits were contradictory to combat other symptoms related to menopause, they saw that acupuncture did positively affect both the frequency and severity of hot flashes.

In women between 40 and 60 years old who were included in the meta-analysis, the effects of various forms of traditional acupuncture were evaluated, including Chinese medicine acupuncture (TCMA), acupressure,

electroacupuncture, laser acupuncture and ear acupuncture.

And interestingly, the researchers admit, the results show that all types of acupuncture reduce the frequency and intensity of hot flashes, a benefit that is sustained over time. Although the study did not analyze what possible mechanisms may be behind such benefits, the authors believe that acupuncture succeeds in reducing beta - endorphin levels in the hypothalamus, as a consequence of low estrogen concentrations. Lower levels that could trigger the release of the calcitonin gene-related peptide (CGRP) that affects thermoregulation (the body's ability to regulate its temperature).


"This review shows that there is still much to learn about the causes and treatments of hot flashes in menopause," explains the executive director of the NAMS, Margery Gass, who advocates that acupuncture can be an "effective alternative" to reduce them, "Especially for those women who are looking for non-drug therapies without any side effects."

In fact, a recent work found that approximately half of women who begin to experience menopausal symptoms turn to alternative medicine to combat them.

The latter I can affirm by the growing influx of menopausal women who in recent years I have been treating with positive results in my clinic.

It's May and the Mercury is rising

Mercury poisoning has been plaguing society for centuries. It has been found in the tombs of Egyptian mummies, in recipes for life giving elixirs from the ancient Chinese, and in the cosmetics of the Romans. Our curiosity with mercury led to the toxic metal becoming a staple in medicines worldwide - which subsequently led to the deaths of those who could afford the liquid silver. While the myth of mercury has made its way out of modern medicine, mercury poisoning is still a modern concern. The consequences of industry upon the environment have caused mercury poisoning to become a global crisis. As mercury is released into the atmosphere, it is primarily reabsorbed by the oceans and, subsequently, by the micro-plankton at the bottom of the food chain. Through a process called

biomagnification, the levels of mercury increase as you move up the food chain. In the predatory fish that find their way to our table, the mercury levels have often increased to toxic levels. These toxic levels of mercury can have extremely damaging effects on your health. Mercury poisoning can cause extreme birth defects in children caused by the levels of mercury in their mother's bloodstream. This includes developmental disorders - such as Asperger's, ADD and possibly autism - along with severe physical disabilities. Although the symptoms of mercury poisoning in adults take longer to develop, they can be equally as lifethreatening. Symptoms are wide ranging and can include irreversible neurological damage, neuropathy, seizures and blindness. However, because of the insidious nature of mercury poisoning it is often



misdiagnosed – due to its non-specific symptoms and because of a lack of awareness within the medical community. Furthermore, the global scale of the fishing industry means that the regulation of mercury levels is very difficult. This means that certain fish in your supermarket will contain toxic levels of mercury.

They will carry no warning labels or health advisories, but are still extremely dangerous. Because of this, selfregulation is the only recourse for my patients.

Government agencies in the US and UK recommend limiting your intake of fish to twice a week – and completely removing larger fish such a shark,

swordfish, cazon and marlin from your diet. This is especially important in highrisk groups such as pregnant mothers, women who plan on becoming pregnant, and children under 17.

When it comes to mercury, a zero level is a "normal" level. As long as you eat food that contains mercury, you are putting your body at risk. Ask your doctor to check your mercury levels today. If you want to find out more about mercury levels in marine animals, view the Oscar winning documentary of The Cove.

Walking for good health

Warm up and cool down after walking

The best way to warm up is to walk slowly. Start each walk at a leisurely pace to give your muscles time to warm up, and then pick up the speed. Afterwards, gently stretch your leg muscles – particularly your calves and front and back thighs. Stretches should be held for about 20 seconds. If you feel any pain, ease off the stretch. Don't bounce or jolt, or you could overstretch muscle tissue and cause microscopic tears, which lead to muscle stiffness and tenderness.

It's best to dress lightly when you do physical activity. too many layers can increase sweating and build up body temperature, making you uncomfortable during a walk or possibly cause skin irritations. A gradual cool-down will also prevent muscular stiffness and injury.

Footwear for walking

Walking is a low-cost and effective form of exercise. However, the wrong type of shoe or walking action can cause foot or shin pain, blisters and injuries to soft tissue. Make sure your shoes are comfortable, with appropriate heel and arch supports. Take light, easy steps and make sure your heel touches down before your toes. Whenever possible, walk on grass rather than concrete to help absorb the impact.

Make walking a pleasure

Some suggestions to help make regular walking a pleasurable form of physical activity include:-

- 1. varying where you walk.
- 2. walking the dog.
- 3. walking with friends.
- 4. joining a walking club.

Make walking interesting

Ways to keep your daily walk interesting

include:-

1. If you want to stick close to home and limit your walking to neighbourhood streets, pick different routes so you don't get tired of seeing the same sights. If you feel unsafe walking alone, find one or more friends or family members to walk with.

2. Walk at various times of the day. The sights to see first thing in the morning are bound to differ from those of the afternoon or early evening.

3. Drive to other reserves, park the car and enjoy the views while walking.

4. Explore what's happening around you; notice the sky, the people, the sounds.

Dog walking

A dog that needs regular exercise motivates you to walk every day. You might like the companionship too. If you don't have a dog, and aren't planning on getting one, consider offering to walk a neighbour's dog occasionally.

Suggestions for the safety of your dog and other people on foot include:-

1. Be considerate of other pedestrians and always keep your dog on its leash.

 If you plan to walk in a park, check first to see if dogs are permitted. Many national and state parks and other conservation reserves do not permit dogs.
 Other parks generally permit dog-walking on a leash. Many parks allow dogs off the leash – check with your local council.

4. Always take equipment such as plastic bags and gloves to clean up after your dog.

Walk with others

Walking with other people can turn a bout of exercise into an enjoyable social occasion. Suggestions include: 1. Schedule a regular family walk – this is a great way to pass on healthy habits to your children or grandchildren, and to spend time together, while getting fit at the same time.

2. If you are walking with children, ensure the route and length of time spent walking are appropriate for children, make sure the route and length of time spent

walking are appropriate to their age. 3. Babies and toddlers enjoy long walks in the pram. Take the opportunity to point out, highlight items of interest to young ones, such as vehicles, flowers and other pedestrians.

4. Look for the self-guided nature walks that have been set up in many parks. Younger children enjoy looking for the next numbered post; older ones can learn about the plants and animals of the park, and perhaps take photos or record their experience in other ways.

Safety suggestions while walking

Walking is generally a safe way to exercise, but look out for unexpected hazards. Suggestions include:-

1. See your doctor for a medical check-up before starting a new fitness program, particularly if you are aged over 40 years, are overweight or haven't exercised in a long time.

2. Ensure you read through the pre-exercise selfscreening tool

3. Choose walks that suit your age and fitness level. Warm up and cool down with a slow, gentle walk to ease in and out of your exercise session.

4. Wear loose, comfortable clothing, and appropriate footwear to avoid blisters and shin splints.

5. Wear sunglasses, sunscreen, long sleeves and a hat to avoid sunburn.

6. Take waterproof clothing to avoid getting wet if it rains.

7. Before bushwalking, check the weather forecast and take appropriate safety measures (for example, pack correct clothing).

8. Look for hazards in alpine or coastal areas, such as cliff edges or large waves.

9. Drink plenty of fluids before and after your walk. If you are taking a long walk, take water with you.

DO WE SURVIVE DEATH?

When I was asked to give a talk on life after death, I could have described my own experience of seeing my father after he died, or my mother's visit four hours before her ashes arrived, or the friend who stayed in touch with me after she died. Although I'm convinced we survive death, my own subjective experiences will not convince the sceptics. Instead I decided to talk about the evidence for life after death, of which there is a great deal. I began with a quote from Albert Einstein: "What we have called matter is energy whose vibration has been lowered to be perceptible to the senses. There is no matter." Most scientists acknowledge that they know relatively little about the universe. About 4% to be precise! Cosmologists say that dark matter and energy make up 96% of the universe but nobody knows what it is, how it works, or how it interacts with matter and energy. Stephen Hawking admitted: "We have no idea how the world really works. All we do is build up models which seem to prove our theories."

Many Quantum Physicists including Amit Goswami, Michio Kaku and Joyce Hawkes are exploring consciousness through Bio-Scientific research. Joyce Hawkes was an atheist until she had a near death experience in which she met her deceased mother, grandmother and a Being of Light. She is now a healer who works with shamans and conducts research into what happens in the brain when we are kind, compassionate and loving.

Rupert Sheldrake, a Cambridge don, researcher at the Royal Society, Harvard Scholar and Fellow of Clare College, is a pioneering biologist taking science away from materialism. He explores the nature of consciousness and writes about the kind of phenomena that science dismisses but people are fascinated by: telepathy, the success rate of alternative medicine, how dogs know when their owners are coming home, and how we know when we are being stared at. Animals and birds appear to behave in a non-local manner, e.g. when a certain number of birds in England learned how to open the tops of milk bottles left out by milkman, suddenly all birds in Europe began to do it. This supports the theory that distant particles, once in contact, somehow remain connected no matter how far apart they may be. Physicists call these events "non-local". Change one particle and the other instantly changes to the same degree. A non-local interaction links up one location with another without crossing space and without delay. Henry Strapp, a leading interpreter of quantum theory, says that non-locality could be the "most profound discovery in all of science." Sheldrake explores the phenomenon of instantly shared remote knowledge which he calls Morphic Resonance. Animals hear frequencies in much higher ranges than we do. They know when an earth-quake is about to happen which Sheldrake suggests could be used to predict earth-quakes and evacuate people in time. Apparently, this is already being explored in China. Valerie Hunt is internationally recognized for her pioneering research on human energy fields. Holding advanced degrees in psychology and physiological science from Columbia University, she discovered vibrational patterns during pain, disease, and in emotional and spiritual states. She created the first human energy field model based on 25 years of sophisticated electronic field research and extensive clinical studies. The electromagnetic human bio-field led to stunning new information about the mind, body, emotions and extraordinary human capabilities in higher states of consciousness. She used high frequency instruments, the first being the telemetry



instrument used by NASA to monitor the astronauts' physiological states during the first manned space flights. Dr Hunt also studied the effects of shamanic healing and consciousness. She discovered that brain waves create a slow wave from zero to 20 cycles per second but the heart creates a larger and faster wave up to 225 cycles per second. Life is electro-magnetic. All matter consists of electrons spinning around a nucleus whether alive or dead. We live in an electrical and magnetic field. The heart has the strongest electrical and magnetic field being 100 times stronger than the brain. It has been measured by the HeartMath institute in America. The ancient Egyptians recognised the Intelligence of the Heart and portrayed it being weighed against the Feather of Truth after death. NASA sent a satellite into space which recorded a huge shift in the Earth's magnetic field immediately after the death of Princess Diana and after 9.11. Collective human emotion created this shift. It could be called a Mass Movement of the Heart. In humans there are two electrical systems. The first is the nervous system and brain. The 2nd system is an electromagnetic field emanating from atoms. This energy is called an aura or energy field. It is unique in that it is 'continuous' while all other electrical recordings of heart, brain and muscles are on-off signals. This corona is a halo or mist around a living body and is called chi, life-force, prana and aura. Beyond the physical there is another field of energy at a higher frequency. It is 8 -10 times faster than the other biological electricity from the body's surface. Electrical currents associated with the mind and human consciousness were first recognised by Valerie Hunt at UCLA. This data has been incorporated into an area called "mind-field research" and shows that the mind is not limited to the brain. A DC shift, also called an openmind field, occurs during meditation, hypnosis, trance or trauma

Valerie Hunt wrote "Infinite Mind: the science of human vibrations of consciousness." Her Mind Mastery Meditation CDs and The Body Electric video are available on line.

Rosalyn Bruyere is a clairvoyant who sees auras and writes about the chakras. She has collaborated with physicians and scientists including Valerie Hunt. She is a healer who says disease first appears in the aura before it appears in the body, and at this early stage it can be prevented. During an altered state the aura is expanded.


