





#### Four people die in less than an hour in two traffic accidents in Malaga

The Civil Guard has arrested a person for the crash on a secondary road near Coín. The other accident occurred on the A-7 motorway near Malaga.

Four people have died and another two have been injured in separate traffic accidents that occurred during the early morning, and in less than an hour, in the province of Malaga.. Malaga roads have claimed up to 21 victims so far this year, 13 of them so far this summer. On August 7th and 8th, a motorcyclist, a driver and a pedestrian died in Antequera, Teba and Málaga respectively after suffering traffic accidents. The first died after colliding with his motorcycle against a car on the A-7281 road. The second after colliding his car against a truck on the A-384 road. The third had gotten out of his damaged vehicle on the A-7 motorway inside the Churriana tunnel when he was run over by another car, according to sources from the Malaga Traffic Management Centre. The last long weekend in August left 17 deaths in traffic accidents throughout Spain, one less than in 2022. Most of the accidents occurred on conventional roads and half were caused by leaving the road. From the beginning of the year to the 15th of this month, 675 people have lost their lives on the road, 5% less than in the same period last year,

according to Traffic data.

# Explosion at a gas station in Almería causes four injuries

A strong explosion at a gas station in the Almería municipality of San José has seriously injured four of its employees who were carrying out cleaning tasks in a storage chest. Three of them are in the Torrecárdenas hospital, one in the ICU; and another has been transferred to the Virgen del Rocío Hospital in Seville, a reference for burns in Andalusia, according to what police sources.

## Sea turtles colonize the Spanish coast

Climate change pushes the species to spawn along the entire coast from Girona to Malaga and 26 nests have already been reported this summer, the highest number since the first was recorded in 2001.

#### Civil Guard investigates the discovery of the bodies of a woman and a man in a house in the Seville municipality of Osuna

The Civil Guard of Seville is investigating the discovery of the bodies of a woman and a man in an advanced state of decomposition in a house in the town of Osuna (17,442 inhabitants). The couple had been residing in the municipality for a short time, according to sources from the Civil Guard. The neighbours maintain that he was from Barcelona and she was from the Ukraine; and that they would be between 40 and 50 years old. A marijuana plantation has also been found in the two-story house, according to sources familiar with the investigation.

## Mass tourism leads Nerja to close the Chillar river

The flood of visitors has destroyed the biodiversity of one of the tourist attractions of the Malaga town. The great risk of fire in the area has triggered the measure. The Chillar river, in Nerja is one of the iewels of the Sierras de Teieda. Almijara y Alhama Natural Park, in the east of the province of Málaga. Its simple entrance, the ease of exploring it on foot, the surprising rock formations known as cahorros, its landscape and the refreshing pools have made it one of the favourite destinations for locals and tourists: in summer it reaches up to 4,000 visitors a day.



## The woman who was presumed dead in a traffic accident in Granada was suffocated before the accident

Her death was initially linked to the accident she suffered on May 6th when she was traveling with her husband, a man who escaped unharmed, committed suicide a few hours later. The Investigating Court 5 of Motril (Granada), which works for violence against women, will be in charge of investigating the death by suffocation of a neighbour of this municipality initially linked to the accident of the car in which she was traveling with her husband, who committed suicide hours later. The accident in which they found the body of the victim, a 39-year-old resident of Motril, took place on May 6th on the A-44 highway. According to the first information offered by the victim's husband at the time, he wanted to avoid an obstacle on the road, swerved and caused the car to leave the road and fall down a drop of about three meters. However, the definitive data from the autopsy have confirmed that the death of the victim is not compatible with the traffic accident and that she died of suffocation.

# 6,000 litres of oil in Teba (Málaga) with a value close to 50,000 euros, stolen

At least 6,000 litres of extra virgin olive oil have been stolen from the Terraverne mill, in Teba (Málaga), with a market value of close to 50,000 euros, after the surveillance cameras were deactivated, according to sources from the company. The thieves took nine pallets of oil bottles of various references at a rate of 600 litres each and also products that were not packaged and that the thieves themselves would have packaged, who also let part of the oil spill on the floor. They have also caused damage to a packaging plant and have stolen computers, tables, chairs or fans, among other material. An employee discovered the theft when he went to the facilities and found the entrance doors forced.



# A civil guard arrested for hitting a local policeman in the face with his badge at the Malaga fair

The civil guard was off duty and bothering a woman in Larios street. An agent from the Investigation and Prevention Group (GIP) of the Local Police, who was in civilian clothes, saw a man on Calle Larios who seemed to make a woman uncomfortable. Given the situation, the local police officer approached to attend to what was happening, but the woman, who refused to report, stated that she was fine and that it was her boyfriend , who "had too much to drink at the Fair". However, the policeman asked the man to identify himself and show him his ID, but the civil guard refused and showed him his badge with which he hit him in the face while calling him a "clown". The local police officer, after what happened, notified the rest of the units to arrest the man, whom they later located in the surroundings of Plaza del Obispo. The local police officer went to a health centre with minor injuries. The civil guard was transferred to the police station, where proceedings were conducted before turning him over to court.

## The Civil Guard has intervened more than 34,000 kilos of food in poor condition

The armed institute, which has denounced one of the two companies for administrative violations and is investigating the manager of the other, has explained that the investigation began in May, when they obtained information about the commission of possible irregularities by two commercial companies in two industrial buildings in Torrevieja. In them, it was allegedly marketed with expired food products that were distributed between Spain and Portugal. Likewise, the existence of two other establishments in the towns of Coslada (Madrid) and Marbella (Málaga) were found, where the same irregularities were being committed.

In June, agents simultaneously carried out various inspections in the three establishments

Foods with manipulated best-before dates , others expired and others in a poor state of preservation were located and intervened, all of them ready for sale and distribution. After intervening all the food in poor condition, about 34,000 kilos, the manager of one of the companies was investigated for a crime related to the market and consumers for food fraud.

# A man arrested after trying to sexually assault a young woman at the Malaga fair

The two left a booth together and right after the young man took the girl to a secluded area where he tried to abuse her. The Local Police of Malaga have arrested a man as the perpetrator of a sexual assault on a young woman whom he had met in a booth at the Cortijo de Torres at the Malaga Fair. The girl screamed for help and was rescued, at first, by a group of young people, almost at the time the local police officers arrived, who were on duty in the area at that time. Thanks to the description offered by the young woman and the witnesses, the alleged attacker was located in the Real, arrested and brought to justice. The victim was transferred to a hospital.

# Smoking club in Estepona that functioned as a point of sale for drugs, dismantled

The place that housed a smoking club in Estepona (Málaga), which lacked a municipal opening license and in which drug trafficking was allegedly trafficked, has been dismantled by the Police in an operation in which a 29-year-old man has been arrested.

The investigators verified that the same person in charge of opening and closing the club was also in charge of supplying the drug to the people who travelled there, both to consume it inside the premises and to buy it and take it outside.

# Gay venue in Seville set on fire at dawn, investigation into whether it was a homophobic attack

Customers were evacuated and there were no injuries. The gay venue in Seville suffered an "intentional" fire that is now being investigated to determine whether or not it was a homophobic attack.

Quickly, the clients that were in the club were evicted and the Fire Brigade and the Local Police were notified. "Fire officials confirmed that it was an intentional fire", since they had put a roll of paper in it and set it on fire "with the idea that the wooden door would burn" and spread inside, they explain. in his message on the networks.

#### Approved works for the bike lane - north between Nerja and Maro with a budget of 582,254 euros

The mayor of Nerja has approved, by decree, the file for the contracting of the works of the bicycle lane that will link Nerja and Maro through the northern area of the National Highway 340.

He has also approved the specifications for the bidding for said works.

The works have a base tender budget of 582,254.81 euros, 80% co-financed with European funds as it is part of the Nerja Sustainable and Integrated Development Strategy (EDUSI) and 20% the City Council.

The project corresponds to the "Nerja sustainable urban mobility" program.

#### A secret binge-drinker reaches out for help and gets "a life beyond her wildest dreams".

Ava speaks about how she kidded herself for years and was in denial about her secret drinking. After joining Alcoholics Anonymous she found, "a life beyond her wildest dreams," here is her story.....

"My name is Ava, I am 79 years old with no children. Before I retired, I held a senior position, in elerge multinational services conglomerate

Our family history doesn't include much alcohol use, but there were plenty of other mental health problems, including depression, and emotional absenteeism. I spent 9 months of the year at boarding school and then was farmed out to various family members during the holidays.

I started drinking in my early 20s, and I used alcohol, along with relationships, to change the way I felt. I was a secretive, bingedrinker. I was always too sick with my hangovers to drink daily. Publicly I would manage my alcohol use, only having a couple; then I would go home, and in private, drink to blackout.

I always knew there was a problem with the way I drank, normal people didn't hide their drinking. I did. Normal people could stop once they started, I couldn't. But I was in denial because I was able to give up for short periods of time, I kidded myself I was in control. There was no single incident, or specific occasion, that I would count as my rock bottom. It was more a feeling of being totally broken. Nating myself, I was sick to death of the lies. I loathed looking at myself in the mirror, I had no self-respect. The unmanageability of my life was getting worse, I was sick and tired, of being sick and fired! I knew I needed help.

gh friends I heard lics Anonymous 1 long to my first m was in April 2004. right-eyed and bushy tailed were laughing, I warned som of what they had. Then the sharing of what they had. Then the sharing of the sharing is the sharing is the share sha hanks to this w erful programme, wha as helpe discover, and the along the way, I h since that first m le i hav had a unce that first m grateful that I lost I am v raving v s been early on. It hasn't elways been easy, I have been through some

easy, I have been through some incredibly tough times, but with the support and fellowship I have stuck to my programme and stayed sober.

On a daily basis, I follow the suggestions laid out by the Big Book of Alcoholics Anonymous, and I listen to my sponsor (like a guide), who I have had from the very beginning, and who was (and continues to be, right to this day) very gentle and patient with me. I help others and do service within (and outside) the fellowship whenever I can.

(and outside) the fellowship whonever I can. I cannot praise the 12-step model of recovery enough. It is a design for living, which has helped ma get my self-respect back and brought contentment into my life. The programme has helped me realise how important it is to have a purpose and be useful. It has allowed me to make wonderful friends and generally made me a more open honest person, who accepts responsibility for my actions and behaviour. Life now is, as we say in the felfowship, "happy, joyous and free". I have a "life beyond my wildest dreams" for which I am eternally grateful. To anyone struggling with alcohol, I would say come along to a meeting, everyone is welcome, you will be cared for, and loved. This programme works if you work it! It worked for me!"

There are meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous, with friendly people who understand, held daily, throughout the Costa del Soi. Meetings are free to attend, and anyone who thinks they may have a problem with alcohol is welcome. # My garden in Spain...



#### **Corn Flowers**

BLUE FLOWERS HAVE always held a special attraction for me. The deep azure blue of the corn flower, the sky blue of the scabiosa and since coming to Spain the wonderful smokey blue of the Jacaranda, which are now in bloom here. They are a beautiful sight, these trees with their canopies of blue blossoms hanging over white walls in the various urbanisations.

People who have travelled to South America where it is prolific, remember seeing this tree for the first time on their holidays and many a photograph has been taken of them. Whilst walking a coastal path not too long ago, my husband and I came across a huge water tank outside the backwall of a finca. There was water pouring in from a huge pipe and a family of frogs resident in one corner. What caught my attention next was the mass of violet/blue fluffy flowers that were growing out of the cracks in the finca walls, crevices in the little walls and along the path edge. I picked a few of these lovely flowers to help me identify them, sure enough they were a variation on Trachelium Caeruleum (Passion of Violet). If I were lucky enough to get a bunch of flowers in England or if I treated myself, this flower would be included as it is so beautifully unusual. The variety that I collected from around the water tank is Trachelium Rumelianum. Slightly different as the flower heads start off as green spikey balls before they burst into bloom. It hails from Greece and Bulgaria and is described as entirely at home in crevices plantings, borders and rockeries, which I can confirm. One of the projects for my garden that has taken upmost of my 'planning' time on paper as well as in my head is 'what to do with the grass?' Some writings ago, I mentioned that the lawn had suffered badly last year during a particular hot week, when our supply of mains water was cut off and we had to rely on what was in the 'deposito' for use in the house only. The problem was a fractured water mains pipe along the Frigiliana road. Eventually it was repaired, but by that time the sun had

done a good job of baking patches in the lawn. The grasses were a mixture of the tough Spanish Grama Gruesa and what looked like an English grass. The tender non Spanish stuff all shrivelled up and died leaving brown swathes through the greener Grama. It looked like an irregular patchwork guilt. At this point I started to consider a gravel garden and began making treks around various builders yards to look at what was available and how it could be delivered to our house. In between these trips to builders yards, I have managed to rake out most of the dead grass, the 'thatch' as the garden book calls it and the Grama is now sending out stolons, (a new word for me) across the bare patches. It responds to watering well and I have been assured that once all these 'stolons' have sort of 'meshed'. It will be a tough, easy to care for green lawn, hopefully.

Around the builders yards, I found a supplier of gravel and the lorry to bring it up here. But the gravel was very grey looking and would have looked too harsh spread over a large area. In another yard, I found the right stuff. Small round pebbles in subtle colours of beige, grey and offwhite. Quite expensive though, as it comes from a riverbed in Jaen.

The access to our house is difficult for most cars, so to get any gravel delivered to our garden, it will have to be tipped over a garden wall from an empty field next door. It gets more complicated! Next question asked of the builder's yard man, 'Does it come in sacks, to be lifted up and over by a crane off the lorry?' A very definite 'no'.

We would have to knock down part of the wall down, so that the truck can tip1 The other alternative would be a wheelbarrow. It is a considerable distance from some dumping point.

My assistant, sorry husband said 'no way' to that last suggestion! So for the time being I am encouraging the stolons, whilst I mull over the cost and logistics of it all!


He is a very big dog (approx.. 50 kilos) and a great and loyal guard dog but would do better as an only dog and does not get along with cats.





#### SPANISH PLANTS THAT ARE POISONOUS TO DOGS

Dogs are notorious for getting their noses into things they shouldn't. Besides their dog food, they'll happily snuffle up anything they come across, from litter on the street to the newly planted flowers and plants in your garden. And while some of the stuff your dog comes across is just gross, other items can be downright dangerous. In fact, there are tons of poisonous plants for dogs that can harm your pet. Summer means that there are lots of flowers and plants in bloom in our gardens and in pots on our patios and terraces. Beautiful to look at – but do you know which ones are toxic to dogs and which ones aren't?

#### OLEANDER

You'll find oleander everywhere in Spain. It's an incredibly hardy plant that can survive extremes of temperatures and can be covered in pink, yellow or white flowers. However it is one of the most toxic plants for pets and even ingesting a tiny amount can lead to arrythmia and death. There isn't a single part of the oleander plant that dogs can safely ingest. This shrub is completely toxic to dogs.



#### SAGO PALM

All parts of the Sago Palm are poisonous, but the seeds (nuts) are the most toxic to pets and are easier for them to eat. The sago palm can cause severe damage to the liver and potentially death when they are ingested by dogs. Can cause vomiting, lethargy, haemmorage and liver disease.



#### LILY

Plants of the lily family are some of the most dangerous to pets and a single bite can cause vomiting, weakness, irregular heartrate. Every part of the plants is toxic – even the pollen! This family of flowering plant includes lily of the valley, calla lily and peace lily varieties, all of which are potentially toxic for dogs.



#### IVY

Ivy is a vine that grows readily in Spain. All parts of the plant are toxic, but the fruit in particular can be deadly.

Touching it can cause skin irritations and symptoms after ingestion include vomiting and fever.



#### CYCLAMEN

The substance cyclamine which can be found in the plant's roots is highly poisonous to cats and dogs.

Ingesting can lead to vomiting, kidney failure and in some cases even paralysis. Depending on the amount of root fibres ingested, the animal may even die.



#### POINSETTIA Seen everywher

Seen everywhere in Spain at Christmas time and its pretty red colour makes it interesting and appetising for animals. The toxicity of poinsettia lies in the milky liquid inside the leaves and stems. 



"With this intervention, the deposit will be interconnected to the municipal supply network, which will ensure the supply, dispensing an adequate provision of the water supply service, "José Alberto Armijo has pointed out.

Warm Eggplant & Mint Salad Warm Eggplant and Mint Salad

#### Serves:- 1

#### Inaredients:-

- 1 large eggplant, cut into 1-inch cubes (about 1 pound) 3 tsp olive oil, divided
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, plus more to taste
- 1/2 lemon, juiced (about 1 tablespoon)
- 1 pinch sugar
- Freshly cracked black pepper, to taste
- 2 tablespoons fresh mint, roughly chopped

#### Preparation:-

Preheat the oven to 400°F. Toss the eggplant cubes, 2



tablespoons of the olive oil, and salt directly on a quarter sheet pan and roast for 30 minutes, or until caramelized and tender. Turn off the oven. #### Ingredients:-

- 1/2 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- Pinch of ground black pepper
- 1 boneless, skinless chicken breast, sliced into  $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch pieces
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper

walnuts, and cooked chicken and dress with the vinaigrette.

#### Ingredients:-

- 1 pound regular or gluten-free spaghetti
- 2 cloves garlic
- 1/2 cup raw slivered almonds
- 2 large cooked and peeled red beets, coarsely chopped
- 1/3 cup olive oil

2 tablespoons red wine vinegar

Kosher salt

Minced fresh chives, for garnish



Vegan Beet Pesto Pasta

#### **Preparation:-**

Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Add the pasta and cook until al dente.

Meanwhile, place the garlic and almonds in the bowl of a food processor fitted with the blade attachment and pulse until the almonds are a fine meal and the garlic is minced. Add the beets, olive oil, and vinegar and pulse until you have a smooth pesto-like sauce. Season to taste with kosher salt. When the pasta is ready, toss with the pesto and season to taste with kosher salt. Serve hot. (If you want to serve the pasta at room temperature or chilled, rinse the pasta with cold water before tossing with the pesto).

#### Makes:-16 to 20

#### Ingredients:-

2 large eggplant, sliced 1 inch thick 24 oz jar tomato sauce 20 slices provolone cheese, mozzarella works too 3-4 oz fresh cherry tomatoes, sliced 1 cup fresh spinach 1/2 tsp salt Pepper flakes, optional

#### **Preparation:-**

Preheat your oven to 425 F. In two baking trays arrange the sliced eggplants. Sprinkle the Himalayan salt and bake for 15-20 minutes. Remove the bake eggplant from the oven and turn your broiler on.

Spread 1 tablespoon of tomato sauce over each eggplant round followed by one slice of provolone.

Arrange some fresh spinach and cherry tomatoes over the cheese and broil for 3-5 minutes.

Make sure you keep a close look while the eggplant is under the broiler as they can burn really fast. Serve while still hot.

#### Serves:- 4 to 6

Ingredients:-1/4 cup sugar 1/4 cup water 1 cup sliced peaches, skins left on 1 cup sliced plums, skins left on 1 cup cherries, stemmed and pitted 1/2 cup peach brandy 1 (750-ml) bottle dry Riesling, chilled

#### Preparation:-

In a small saucepan, combine the sugar and water, and heat

Add the cold Riesling and chill until ready to serve. Ideally overnight.



#### SWOLLEN LEGS: CAUSES, TIPS AND EXERCISES



The heaviness and swelling of the legs are part of the symptoms that can appear after the presence of circulatory problems, which is why taking preventive and corrective measures to help improve them is of great interest to those who suffer from them, in this article we explain with greater detail of what it treats, what factors can trigger them and some treatment options to improve.

What is swelling and heavy legs? The feeling of heaviness and swelling of the legs are characteristic signs and symptoms of poor circulation. Frequently they usually appear due to fluid retention in the lower limbs or because they are suffering from venous insufficiency. "The feeling of heaviness and swelling of the legs are characteristic signs and symptoms of poor circulation.' Venous insufficiency causes the passage of blood flow to be difficult, preventing the blood from performing the venous return efficiently, thus facilitating the accumulation of liquids or blood at the level of the lower limbs, and in turn

triggering the sensation of heavy and swelling legs and then the manifestation of the dreaded varicose veins.

#### Types of swelling in the legs.

There are different types of swelling in the legs and this depends on the specific area or area that is inflamed. Among the most common we find:

**1.** Swelling or inflammation in one leg or in both limbs: this presentation may be associated with possible altered conditions in the general systems of the body if it refers to both legs, while if it is in only one it may be due to a particular problem of that leg.

2. Swelling in a specific area or throughout the leg: this inflammation is characterized by appearing in a specific area as a result of conditions such as arthritis, skin lesions, infectious or allergic processes.

**3.** Sudden or gradual swelling or inflammation: frequently the swelling occurs gradually and the person does not realize it at first until it is really visible and the symptoms of tension appear, while if the swelling suddenly originates in only one leg, it may be a symptom of deep vein thrombosis.

**4.** Swelling with or without the presence of pain: swelling does not usually cause pain, but rather a sensation of tension in the area, however, in cases where pain exists, it may be related to infections, injuries or joint problems, or the presence of deep vein thrombosis.

According to the type of swelling present, it is possible to determine the cause or triggering factor of these signs and symptoms.

## Causes and risk factors of swollen legs.

The causes and risk factors that trigger swollen or heavy legs have currently been increasing, and that is that prolonged postures, a sedentary lifestyle, and bad eating habits favour the appearance of circulatory problems. Among the most common factors we find: • Obesity: body overweight is one of the frequent causes of the appearance of venous insufficiency as well as edema in the lower limbs.

High cholesterol due to excessive

consumption of fatty foods and fried foods: poor diet and excessive consumption of high-fat foods can cause atherosclerosis and with it the appearance of circulatory problems.

Excessive consumption of alcohol and tobacco: tobacco and alcohol contain substances that are harmful to health. In the case of tobacco, it causes damage to the walls of the veins and thus predisposes them to work incorrectly in the functioning of the blood supply. , while alcohol consumption affects the kidneys and liver causing the functioning of these organs to deteriorate and kidney failure or insufficiency can be reached.
Arterial hypertension due to heart failure and difficulty returning blood flow to the lungs, which accumulates in the legs, ankles and feet.

• Family history of atherosclerosis: atherosclerosis is a condition of great concern today since a large percentage of deaths derive from this condition, due to the accumulation of plaques on the walls of the arteries, so if there is a history of this condition it is important to be vigilant.

• Lack of physical activity and a sedentary lifestyle can cause poor blood circulation and, consequently, swelling and a feeling of tiredness in the legs.

• Aortic thickening due to advanced age: over the years, calcium deposits may accumulate in the aortic valve, causing it to harden and narrow.

• Diabetes Mellitus due to a predisposition to fluid retention and high blood sugar levels that damage the blood vessels and nerves in the legs and feet.

• Kidney, heart or liver failure: suffering from these diseases increases the probability of suffering from circulatory problems and with it the appearance of symptoms of inflammation and heaviness in the legs.

• Consumption of some medications such as antidepressants, steroids or hormones increase the probability of leg swelling, as well as the appearance of symptoms of heaviness.

What are the symptoms of possible circulatory problems? In addition to the feeling of heaviness in the legs and their swelling, it is possible to find other signs and symptoms that may be related to problems in the circulatory system such as:

- Shooting and burning pain (burning pain)
- Tiredness in the legs
- Sensation of itching and with it the appearance of pruritus
- Changes in skin coloration
- Presence of ulcerations
- Dry and hard skin
- Poor wound healing
- Sensations of tingling and numbness
- Presence of spider veins

#### When is it important to see a doctor?

It is important to see a doctor when, in addition to the presence of swollen legs and a feeling of heaviness, other significant symptoms are added that compromise the well-being of people, such as respiratory distress, chest pain, dizziness, coughing up blood or lack of air when making some effort.

In addition, if you have a history of kidney, heart, or liver failure and the lower limb or limbs swell, redden, or are much hotter to the touch, evaluation and consultation with a specialist is necessary to determine the cause.

#### What can be done to improve swelling and heavy legs?

Conservative treatment for the existence of symptoms of swelling and heavy legs requires in the first instance a medical health assessment to determine the possible cause, and then start with pharmacological, therapeutic or surgical treatment if necessary.

From physiotherapy, the implementation of exercises that promote circulation and mobility of the lower limbs, together with the application of a lymphatic drainage massage are part of the main treatment, in addition to daily activities of daily living. It is important to take into account some recommendations and tips to care for and prevent the appearance of circulatory problems, it is also important, some of them are:

Mobilize your legs at any time, performing exercises that favour the proper functioning of the venous return will be of great help to prevent the symptoms of heaviness and swelling from appearing.
If your work activity requires prolonged postures, both standing or sitting, remember to take active rest periods (active breaks).
Avoid prolonged use of heat sources such as the use of saunas, sun exposure, hot baths or waxing.

- Take walks or some low-impact physical activity to put your
- circulatory system to work effectively.Avoid excess weight and constipation
- Avoid excess weight and cor
   Avoid wearing heels
- Reduce the consumption of foods with excess salt and sugars, since the high consumption of them causes an increase in blood pressure, and with it arterial hypertension, pathologies associated with it such as myocardial infarction, kidney disorders, cerebrovascular accidents. and diabetes mellitus.

• Avoid the use of very tight garments in this way you will favour the best functioning of your circulatory system

#### Recommended exercises.

Foot circle exercise - From the lying position, placing a pillow or cushion under your legs, you must make circles with your feet, making them very wide and well defining the range of mobility of the ankle.

Elevated Legs Bicycle Exercise - From the lying position you will raise your legs, to then simulate the action of a bicycle, it is important that you mark the flexion and extension of the foot well during the exercise.

Tiptoe exercise to activate calf pumping - Locating yourself in the standing position and on tiptoes, you must perform several repetitions of this exercise in a static way, that is, without displacement, you will have to perform at least 20 repetitions to activate your calves.

Toe walking exercise -This exercise is a sequence of the previous exercise and for this you will only have to maintain the tiptoe position but this time you will make a small displacement or walk in this position for about 30 seconds.

# A number of studies over the years have linked smoking with schizophrenia, but no one has really been sure which one came first.

Many psychiatrists, psychologists and neurobiologists felt schizophrenia predisposed you to risk-taking behaviour making you more likely to start smoking – then there were the mental-health professionals who suggested that there was something about smoking that contributed to the development of the disorder.

However, a new analysis has given additional clarity to this 'chicken and egg' question, indicating that smoking may indeed be the cause rather than the effect.

The new analysis, conducted by researchers at King's College London's Department of Psychosis Studies, analyzed sixtyone studies from around the world from 1980 to 2014 containing data from 15,000 smokers and almost 273,000 nonsmokers.

The report built on the relationship between the use of substances and the risk of developing psychosis.

Cannabis has long been the usual suspect, but these researchers approached the analysis with the hypothesis that tobacco smoking also played a part in increasing the risk of developing psychosis. Not only were the smokers three times more likely to develop psychosis, they also developed psychotic illness one year earlier than non-smokers. The Missing Link: Smoking and Psychosis.

One clear message the research highlighted was the high level of smoking among those with mental health problems and that smoking is not necessarily simply something that alleviates symptoms - the so-called 'self-medication hypothesis'. The figure is striking: 42% of all cigarettes smoked in England are consumed by people with mental health problems. While the life expectancy of the general population continues to climb, those with a severe mental health problem have their lives cut short by up to 30 years – in part due to smoking. Since the 1950s, rates of smoking have dramatically reduced in the population while the number of people with psychosis has remained constant. Why has the incidence of psychosis not mirrored the reductio in the overall numbers of smokers? Two factors might explain this. First institutional neglect has held up efforts and resources employed to reduce smoking for people with mental health problems - until recently, public health campaigns have pretty much ignored

this group thinking that 'Surely they have enough to worry about without being nagged about smoking' or 'It's one of the few pleasures they have'. Not, surprisingly, the tobacco industry, more than aware of this loyal group of customers, has played a sinister role in keeping the cigarettes lit with these patients. The industry actively funded research supporting the 'selfmedication' hypothesis, pushing the idea that people with psychosis need tobacco to relieve their symptoms. The industry is a key player in obstructing hospital smoking bans, which they perceive as a threat to tobacco consumption. Worse still, they market cigarettes specifically to people with mental health problems. People with psychosis use substances for the same reasons we all do: to relax or feel less stressed.

Contrary to many people's preconceptions, individuals with mental health problems are no different to any of us in their desire and ability to quit smoking.

Given the clear links between smoking and mental health – that is particularly good news.

#### Mediterranean diet during pregnancy improved 2-year-olds' cognitive, social abilities

Mothers who followed the Mediterranean diet while pregnant improved their children's cognitive, social and emotional development at age 2 compared with children whose mothers did not follow the diet, according to a new randomized clinical trial. "Despite previous evidence suggesting (an) association between adverse lifestyle (patterns) and poorer child neurodevelopment, no previous studies had evaluated whether lifestyle interventions improved neurodevelopment," said study coauthor Dr. Francesca Crovetto, a postdoctoral researcher at the BCNatal Fetal Medicine Research Center at the Universitat de Barcelona in Spain, via email.

"At year 2 the children's brains are harvesting some of the benefits that they received in their adequate nutrition during their intrauterine life," said Dr. Miguel Martínez-González, a professor of preventive medicine and public health at the University of Navarra in Pamplona, Spain, in an email. He was not involved in the study. "No other dietary model possesses such an impressive accrual of scientific evidence as the traditional Mediterranean diet," said Martínez-González, who is also an adjunct professor of nutrition at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health in Boston. The Mediterranean diet, which features simple, plant-based cooking, has been shown in studies to reduce the risk for diabetes, high cholesterol, dementia, memory loss, depression, stronger bones, a healthier heart and longer life. Children of mothers who took a stress-reduction class during

pregnancy also scored higher in social and emotional well-being as toddlers compared with children of mothers who did not receive the training, according to the study published Tuesday in JAMA Network Open. "Stress is not just a feeling, it is a feeling that

echoes through our endocrine and nervous and immune systems," said Dr. David Katz, a specialist in preventive and lifestyle medicine who founded the nonprofit True Health Initiative, a global coalition of experts dedicated to evidencebased lifestyle medicine. He was not involved in the study. "There are changes in hormone levels with stress, and we should not be surprised to learn that variations in maternal hormones have implications for fetal and neonatal development and health,

"Katz said. "I would hope this study gives people a deep appreciation for what an incredible opportunity there is to use lifestyle as medicine during pregnancy to give our newborns the best possible start in life."

The study followed children born to 1,221 high-risk mothers who were part of The Improving Mothers for a Better Prenatal Care Trial Barcelona, a randomized clinical trial conducted between February 2017 and March 2020. All of the women in the study had been identified as carrying a fetus with a high risk of being born small for their gestational age, a leading cause of infant death.

One group of women was randomized to follow a Mediterranean diet and given free olive oil and walnuts, and met monthly with trained nutritionists who provided recipes, shopping lists and a weekly meal plan.

Another group of high-risk women was assigned to eight weeks of pregnancy yoga, meditation and mindfulness group sessions and home-based interventions, which all focused on the relationship between the mother and the developing baby. A third group of women was given standard prenatal care. The initial results of the study were published in December 2021. Nearly 22% of women who received only prenatal care gave birth to babies of low weight, the research team found. The number of low-weight births dropped to 15.6% of the women who attended stress-reduction classes and 14% of the women who ate a Mediterranean diet.

The Mediterranean diet focuses on fruits, vegetables, whole grains, beans and seeds, with a few nuts and a heavy emphasis on extra-virgin olive oil.

Approximately two years after the women gave birth, researchers visited 626 children, or representing about half of the original study group, and administered the Bayley Scales of Infant and Toddler Development, a well-known measure of cognitive, social and emotional infant development.

On the cognitive test, there was a 5-point favourable difference between children whose mothers ate a Mediterranean diet and those in the control group who did not, Katz said. A new study has found that an 8-week mindfulness and meditation program was just as effective at reducing anxiety symptoms as a common anti-anxiety medication.

"Overwhelmingly, fetal nutrients are a byproduct of maternal diet," he added. "Maternal dietary pattern and quality will thus influence fetal exposures to diverse nutrients and will even influence taste preferences early in life."

Both stress reduction and the Mediterranean diet increased scores of social and emotional development, but only the Mediterranean diet intervention was statistically significant — meaning the outcome was greater than chance.

"For me, the most important result and most generalizable for the population of pregnant women is the improvement in the average overall cognitive composite score in the Mediterranean diet group," Martínez-González said in an email.

"The first arm (Mediterranean diet) addressed a more physical and direct aspect: the dietary pattern and the supply of interesting nutrients that are known to be beneficial. They are likely to be important for the development of the child's brain," he added. However, there was an improvement in only

one of the elements of the cognitive score in the stressreduction group compared with controls,


Martínez-González said. "The promotion of meditationmindfulness needs more evidence.

It is likely that it may be beneficial, but further studies are needed."




