Trial date set for Luis Rubiales over forced kiss at World Cup.

A trial date has been set in February for the disgraced former president of the Spanish Football Federation (RFEF), Luis Rubiales, after his unsolicited kiss on the lips of Women's World Cup winner Jenni Hermoso. Rubiales, 46, provoked worldwide outrage by kissing Hermoso during the medal ceremony after Spain beat England to win the World Cup in Australia last year.

Two die in a car accident, the driver tests positive for alcohol and drugs.

A 22 year old young man who has tested positive for alcohol and drugs was arrested by the Local Police in Almeria. The man was identified as the driver of the car that crashed in which an 18 year old girl and a 23 year old male died. The man was arrested at his home shortly after having fled the scene of the accident.

Man arrested in Malaga for selling 'laughing gas'.

Malaga Local Police arrested a 21 year old man after they observed him handing a bottle of nitrous oxide, also known as laughing gas, to another man. in exchange for money. The low price and easy availability have led to consumption among the youngest. The laughing gas can cause suffocation, hallucinations, uncontrolled vocalization, alterations in perception, spatial and temporal disorientation, or reduced sensitivity to pain. In the most serious cases, it can cause everything from fainting to cardiorespiratory arrest.



So-called Islamic State media network dismantled by Spanish Civil Guard.

Spanish authorities have arrested nine people in four cities as part of the crackdown against extremist messages calling for violence against the Euro 2024 tournament and the Paris Olympics. Spain's Civil Guard, in collaboration with Europol and the FBI, has dismantled one of the largest media networks linked to the so-called Islamic State. The global propaganda and messages capable of inciting terrorism were in at least thirty languages. The network also published messages urging an attack on a bus carrying Real Madrid's football players, as well as targeting the Euro 2024 football tournament in Germany and the Paris Olympics.

Foods that will maintain VAT at 0% until June 2025.

The Government will bring to Congress a decree law to extend the VAT reduction on basic foods, which in principle ends June 30th.

The idea is to maintain this measure until June 2025. The foods that will at 0%, if the decree law is approved, are:

Common bread, even frozen, only if it does not contain other additions. Bread flours, not normal flour, pastry flour or batter flour. Milk, liquid, powder, UHT or fresh (pasteurized), as well as concentrated milk, not condensed milk, which has the usual VAT.

All cheeses, fresh, or more or less cured, from cows, sheep, goats... Eggs. Fresh, dried, frozen or fourth-range fruits and vegetables, as long as they do not contain other ingredients.Tubers. Cereals and dried legumes, rice, chickpeas, beans, corn.... Special breads, canned vegetables, fruits, legumes, pre-cooked rice, pre-fried potatoes will maintain VAT at 10%.

Five migrants forced out of smugglers' boat, three arrested.

Spain's National Police, working with Europol and the Guardia Civil, arrested three people for the deaths last November of five migrants who were threatened with a machete and forced to jump off the boat they were travelling in with dozens of other migrants. Thirty-seven migrants had travelled in the boat from Kenitra, Morocco, and had paid between €3.000 and €12.000 for a place on the boat.

Spanish police recover the 4th of five Francis Bacon paintings that were stolen in Madrid in 2015.

Spain's National Police have recovered the fourth of five paintings by Irish-born painter Francis Bacon that were stolen from a Madrid apartment in 2015. The five paintings stolen were said then to be worth a total of €25 million. They were part of a collection owned by a close friend of Bacon, who reported the robbery to police in July 2015. Bacon often visited Madrid, where he spent time studying old master paintings in the Prado Museum. He died in the Spanish capital in 1992, aged 82.

Ford Valencia plant to cut a further 1.600 jobs.

US car manufacturer Ford will cut another 1.600 jobs at its Valencia assembly plant, after already cutting 1.100 jobs last year. Approximately 4.700 work at the factory. The unions were told it plans to cut 600 jobs permanently, but negotiate the possibility of rehiring 1.000 later on. The company plans to boost output from 2027 when production of a new vehicle begins.



Spanish government slams 'trumped-up' charge against PM's brother.

The Spanish government has lashed out over a new 'trumped-up charge' by a far-right linked group, this time targeting David Sánchez, the brother of Prime Minister Pedro Sánchez, prompting a court to open a preliminary probe. David Sánchez works for a provincial council in Badajoz (Extremadura).



Customer attacked in a Nerja café.

The café was located in Calle Antonio Millón, and the incident was captured on video. In the video you can see two middle aged men, one of them with a large wooden stick in one hand, approaching the doors of the café. Then one of the men hits another man with the stick, who was a customer. The victim defends himself and in the struggle he manages to snatch the stick from his attacker. Then the two attackers seem to flee, but they instead take tables and chairs.

First they use the two chairs to attack the victim while he tries to defend himself with the stick that he has taken from them. Then one of them picks up a table and throws it at the victims back, causing him to fall to the ground. A witness then runs towards the man who is badly injured after one of the two attackers hit him again with the same table, then both attackers flee.

Businessmen in central Nerja have reported an increase in robberies, thefts and fights in recent weeks and have asked the authorities for more police presence.

Worker seriously injured by some steel sheets in Nerja.

A worker was seriously injured when some steel sheets fell on him in the Industrial area in Nerja. The man was taken by helicopter to a health center after being freed by the local firefighters.



Nine year sentence for British man who seriously assaulted his girlfriend in Spain.

McInerney pleaded guilty to inlficting serious injuries upon his former partner during a holiday in Marbella. After being caught by her former partner and put in his car, the woman threw herself from the speeding car but her abuser had hold of her arm, so she was dragged down the road before finally breaking free. The victim had several injuries including friction burns, a severe cut to her leg and several spinal fractures.

German man arrested for torture and murder

in Málaga. The National Police arrested a German man suspected of torturing and killing a Serbian citizen in Marbella in 2022.

Spain legalises abortion for teens without parental consent.

Girls aged 16 and 17 now have the choice to terminate their pregnancies in Spain.

Under the law, abortion can be carried out at 14 weeks but if there is a serious risk to the life or health of the pregnant woman or risk of serious anomalies for the fetus, abortion can be carried out at 22 weeks.

Not in the city, not in the countryside: In Spain, rental pressure leaves tenants with nowhere to go.

An analysis of the Bank of Spain report shows the evident difficulty faced by tenants in Spain. Only two regions, Aragón and La Rioja, maintain a rent-to-income (RTI) ratio that does not amount to overexertion anywhere (which



does not exclude that individually, these situations will occur in many cases). On the contrary, in many places it far exceeds 30%, such as in the center of the urban areas of the Madrid region, where the RTI ratio is 44.3%, the highest in the country. The Spanish Law for the Right to Housing considers that "affordable conditions" exist when housing expenses do not exceed 30% of household income. This legal criterion also includes basic utilities (electricity, water, internet...).



82 electric scooter riders fined in Malaga.

Officers in Málaga centre confiscated seven personal mobility vehicles for exceeding a 25km/h speed limit, The user must also be at least 16 years old and not carry passengers animals or objects that hinder safe driving. Electric scooters must have braking systems, a bell, front and rear lights (switched on at any time of day), and reflective features..

Scorched, decapitated body discovered in Alicante.

A dismembered corpse that had been set on fire was discovered on a country road in Alicante. The body, missing it's head, legs and arms, was spotted by a jogger. When the body was discovered it was still smouldering and a suitcase fiull of clothes was found beside it.



Agility Club - Starting in September!

Agility is one of the fastest-growing dog sports (and most fun!) and for good reason. It's great exercise for both you and your dog, and it can build an even deeper relationship between you. Plus, it's exhilarating to watch as your dog races through tunnels, weaves around poles, and leaps over jumps!

Understand the Basics

Dog agility is a sport where you direct your dog through an obstacle course within a certain time limit. Courses typically have between 14-20 obstacles, which can include tunnels, weave poles, tire jumps and seesaws. At each trial you and your dog will race around the unique courses designed for that day. All of this is done with your dog relying solely on the cues and body language you use to direct them on course. Anybody can do agility and any breed can participate – from the smallest dog to the biggest breed!

The Benefits of Agility

Agility training uses your dog's natural instincts. Our pet dogs need look to us for their next meal, but their ancestors were not so lucky. They had to hunt for their food and became adept at finding and chasing prey in order to survive. Often the chase was difficult. Dogs would have had to chase small mammals like rabbits through the woods, over fallen logs, around rocks, up steep embankments, and through narrow passages created by dense undergrowth. The dog had to be fast and nimble to catch his next meal. Agility courses mimic the obstacles a dog in the wild might face in pursuit of dinner and stimulate the dog's natural hunting instinct.

Agility provides good exercise. Some dogs require lots of exercise to burn excess energy, and running through an obstacle course is a great way to do just that.

The athletic challenge keeps a dog fit, helps prevent obesity, increases endurance, and strengthens bones and joints. Plus, an agility course exercises a dog's mind, giving him opportunities to learn and solve problems.

Agility training will also help you keep in shape! You will not actually run through a tunnel or around weave poles, but you will keep moving alongside your dog.

Plus, you will stay focused on your dog's progress, making split-second decisions to help him clock the best time possible while staying on course, so you get a little mental stimulation, too.

Basically, agility training provides good cardiovascular, muscular, and mental exercise for you and your dog.

Agility training bonds dog and owner. Dogs are smart creatures, but it would be difficult for them to successfully complete an agility course without the aid of their owner or handler. The human member of the team guides the dog using verbal cues and hand signals, so good communication between canine and human is essential. This level of communication, and the time spent training, bond a dog and owner in a very special way. As the dog relies on its owner for guidance on the course, they will also become more obedient and well-behaved off the course.

Before you get started in agility, it helps to have the basics of training mastered such as sit, stay, wait and good recall. This will make it much easier for you to direct your dog through the course. 



Barbecued whole fish with lemongrass and turmeric

Ingredients:-

4 x 500g whole fish, cleaned Grapeseed oil, to shallow-fry 150g ginger, peeled, finely shredded 10 garlic cloves, thinly sliced Warrigal greens, coriander leaves and lime wedges, to serve

Lemongrass and turmeric marinade 2 x 10cm stalks lemongrass (inner core only), coarsely chopped 1 cup (20g) kaffir lime leaves, coarsely chopped 1 bunch coriander roots, cleaned 1 1/2 tbs sea salt flakes 3 long green chillies, chopped 8 garlic cloves, chopped 1/4 cup (60g) coarsely chopped ginger 3 cm piece (40g) turmeric, chopped 2 tsp finely grated palm sugar 3 spring onions, chopped 1/4 cup (60ml) grapeseed oil

Preparation:-

For the marinade, whiz all ingredients, except oil, in a blender to a paste. Stir through oil, adding 1 tbs water if too thick.
Using a sharp knife, score fish skin at 3cm intervals. Rub marinade all over skin and inside cavities. Place on a tray, then cover with plastic wrap. Chill for 1-2 hours.
Meanwhile, heat 2cm oil in a frying pan over medium heat. In batches, fry ginger and garlic, for 2-4 minutes until golden. Drain on paper towel.
Remove fish from fridge 20 minutes before cooking. Preheat barbecue or large chargrill frying pan to medium-high heat. Cook fish for 5 minutes each side or until cooked through.

Serve fish on greens with coriander, fried ginger and garlic, and lime wedges.

Anxiety and stress are the body's responses to an uncomfortable, harmful, physically and/or emotionally harmful situation that has been maintained for a long period of time without being resolved. This situation, sustained over time, is capable of exhausting the strongest person, and the body's natural way of encouraging change is expressed through pictures of stress, anxiety, insomnia, anguish, panic,...

Acupuncture allows a reflex effect, through certain points located along the meridians of the body, helping to regulate those organic, nervous or hormonal functions that, due to tension, stress, emotions, rhythm of life, etc. They are unbalanced and cause the symptoms detailed above.

The European Foundation for Traditional Chinese Medicine, among other sources, relates the good results obtained because acupuncture acts on the limbic system.

Which is the part of our brain responsible for regulating the physiological and emotional responses of our body.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Benefits of acupuncture for anxiety

Improved rest and sleep quality, and with it the general state of mind. Suffering fewer moments of suffocation or sudden tachycardia, reducing phobias and compulsive actions (anxiety to eat), tension pain and neuralgia, especially those caused by bruxism.

How many acupuncture sessions are necessary for anxiety?

From the first sessions you can see a significant reduction in the nervous state; and the usual thing is that after 5 sessions a considerable improvement is noted in the rest of the associated symptoms. Similarly, the precise number of sessions varies depending on the person and how long they have been suffering from anxiety.

How often should I do acupuncture?

The first 3/4 sessions it is advisable to do them weekly. Once these have been completed, the second block can be proposed on a fortnightly or monthly basis. Although, depending on the case, it is possible to increase the effect of the treatment in consultation with complementary techniques such as auriculotherapy, phytotherapy or relaxation, extending the space between sessions.

Does acupuncture work for anxiety about eating?

As we indicated previously, acupuncture is ideal to help in states of restlessness, which each person expresses in a different way, from generalized anxiety and nervousness, to insomnia or anxiety about eating or smoking.

How is the acupuncture treatment for anxiety?

The goal of our therapists is always to seek increased wellbeing from the first visit. Therefore, during the first part of the session, the acupuncturist will collect the necessary information through a short interview, listening and observing the person.

With the above information you will be able to evaluate and propose the first treatment in consultation (second part of the session), always painless and aimed at seeing the person's response to acupuncture stimuli.

To end the session, he will listen to how the person has felt, and explain her point of view; proposing a possible treatment, or directing her towards other therapeutic lines, if she considers that they could be more effective.


As a curiosity, let us show you how acupuncture can help you, what is the traditional explanation of Traditional Chinese Medicine for anxiety and give you some examples of its causes according to the "philosophy and through the traditional language" of TCM:

1. Disharmony between Heart and Kidney

The kidney is not in harmony with the heart and liver. In a first phase, it will manifest with oppression and a sensation of fullness in the chest, pain in the heart area, tachycardia, confused mind, red eyes, heaviness in the head. If you do not intervene, you enter the second phase, characterized by diffuse bone pain, psychological exhaustion, frigidity or impotence, loss of sexual desire, heavy legs and swollen ankles. The symptoms are: physical fatigue, feeling of emptiness, weak breathing and voice, facial paleness, brittle hair, frequent colds, sadness. There are also signs of excess in the liver, which the lungs could not contain: muscle contractions, sudden rages and dizziness. Chinese herbal medicine, acupuncture and moxa are effective remedies to treat it.

3. Hepatic spillover:

Bellicose, aggressive, bold and courageous temperaments are the expression of liver strength. However, discontent, irritation and anger, experienced for a long time, harm it, and anxiety is characterized by a state of general nervous tension, irritability, insomnia, intermittent headaches, flushed face, ringing in the ears, arterial hypertension. Chinese medicine is useful to calm the liver, it should be treated with medicinal plants, acupuncture, moxa and massage.

4. Spleen and Stomach Insufficiency:

The stomach receives and breaks down food; the spleen directs its transformation and distribution. "Tobacco, tobacco. Sing sweetly for tobacco. Tobacco is like love"

Those words, from a 16th century song, kept repeating in my head recently as I conducted medical revisions on Spanish construction workers. Considering the historical connection Spain has with tobacco - after all, it brought tobacco to Europe 500 years ago and the first cigarette factory was opened in Sevilla in 1620.

I should not have been surprised that 70% of my construction worker patients smoked. Still, no matter how deeply ingrained tobacco is in Spanish history, culture and habits, it was my responsibility to challenge their smoking addiction. So, what can I tell a smoker that can help them quit? With giant black letters marking each pack of cigarettes with phrases like "Smoking Kills", they already get the point that smoking is bad for them. So, why don't they quit? Because smoking makes them feel good. Make that really, really good. Within eight seconds, after a drag off a cigarette, nicotine starts a chemical cascade of neurotransmitters-brain chemicals - that flood over the brain's pleasure centres. The brain starts working better with nicotine; improving memory, concentration, reaction time. Nicotine works to convince the brain that it is as needed for survival as food, sex and water, which explains why it is a very powerfully

why it is a very powerfully addictive substance. So, how can a smoker quit? While making the decision to stop smoking



is important, don't rely on willpower alone. There are several evidencebased options out there to make quitting a lot easier. Nicotine replacements, such as gums, lozenges or patches, work well for many people and are safe. It is the burnt carcinogens in tobacco that are harmful not the nicotine. Using two different types of nicotine replacements, like a patch and the gum, at the same time can work better for some people than using only one. There are new pharmacological treatments like bupropion, which changes the way your body responds

to nicotine, and varenicline, which bonds to the nicotine receptors in your brain thus reducing your cravings for a cigarette.

Combining some good behaviour therapy to help unlearn the habits and rituals that go along with smoking will increase chances for success.

Counselling really helps to cope without nicotine and to learn to recognise the cues that provoke that cigarette urge. While current smoking restrictions protect non smokers from second hand smoke, these restriction have turned smokers into a new type of "social

Whitby Abbey is at the heart of Britain's spiritual and literary history

Home to saints, vampires and the first English poet: does the new museum do justice to the assorted stories of this magical place?

The 199 steps up to the ruins of Whitby Abbey are a pilgrimage; they always have been. And any good pilgrimage takes effort. Count Dracula (also acquainted with the north Yorkshire town) cheated, the climbed the steps in guise of a black hound. These days, with its new 1.6 million pounds museum and visitor centre, our vampire friend would find a ground floor café and gift shop. Knowing English Heritage, there is probably a bowl of water for dogs, which would have kept the Count happy.

Whitby is a surprise, with a history that puts it at the heart of Britain's spiritual and literary life. It's also a vibrant fishing port, somewhere you can pick a Whitby smokey, smoked herrings, made in a back street smokehouse. And the local jet trade still flourishes. But with more than 15.000 visitors a year to the old abbey, it's museum will certainly have pulling power.

Everyone acknowledges that Whitby Abbey is magical. But that's the easy part. How can it tell a story that includes saints, vampires and an early European controversy with uncanny echoes of Brexit? To understand Whitby, we need to go back to the early 7th century, whose power struggles would have given Game of Thrones a run for its money. Into that turmoil came Hilda, born onto the royal household, who by the age of 13 had seen her father killed by poisoning while in exile.

Hilda renounced all the royal trappings, became a nun and set up a monastery in Whitby. Like many Celtic monasteries, it became a good centre for good works, education, singing and storytelling, and men and women worshipped together. But with there ructions in the church, not least about the date of Easter. While one faction of Christians was still in Lent, another had celebrated Easter. And that's where Whitby and Hilda came in.

The synod of Whitby, held in 664 at the monastery, was set the task of deciding who would come out on the top, the Irish/ native-influenced Celts or the Romans, with their centralising tendencies, won and the great Celtic tradition began to recede.

In 664 in Whitby, the church stood at a crossroads. What emerged was a more organised and centralised institution, one that looked to St. Peter (the gatekeeper of heaven) rather than to the mystical St. John. What was lost in Whitby rang down the generations. But what remained was a kind of spiritual capital that you can sense still at work in the town. During the time of Hilda, Whitby was truly a place of wonders. The early saints were as close to magic as the faith gets. Hilda turned snakes into stone. Nearby saints like Cuthbert had his frozen legs warmed by friendly sea otters. The saints were told tales of battling dark forces that scared them and were hard to explain. Even today, legend has it that the seabirds tip their wings as they pass over the Whitby cliffs in memory of the great female saint. Whitby, though, had another chapter to come and it was inspired by the ruins of Whitby Abbey.

Bram Stoker, business manager of actor Henry Irving, was having a week's break in the town. He was staying at Mrs Veazey's guest house at 6 Royal Cresent and enjoying his daily walks up to the ruined abbey. Stoker spotted empty graves in the graveyard of the Church of St Mary just below the abbey. Their inhabitants hadn't been stolen; the graves marked sailors lost at sea. At the public library he found a book about a Vlad the Impaler.

It was only a short hop to Count Dracula, and Whitby has now become a centre for the gothic. Its ruined abbey is perhaps the most perfect gothic landscape in Britain. Whitby now hosts goth shops, and even goth-friendly hotels. This year is the 25th anniversary of the Whitby Goth Weekend. Its harmless fun, yes. It gives this little east-coast town a niche. But you can't help but think that the towns gothic obsession doesn't do full justice to its layers of mystery and meaning. Whitby has a great deal more to offer than horror. The early saints left a legacy of wonder and a way of looking at the world that has relevance even today. It is perhaps interesting that the Celtic saints tended not to get themselves killed or martyred. They were friendly, local and respected. And they loved poetry and stories and the arts. Indeed, it was in Hilda's monastery that we find evidence of the verse of the first ever English poet. Caedmon was not of high birth, he was a cowherd. But one day in a dream he felt called to write songs and sing about the creation he saw around him. Hilda encouraged him, to write. Fragments of his verse remain:

How he the Lord of Glory everlasting Wrought first for the race of men heaven as a roof-tree, Then made he Middle Earth to be their mansion.

That idea of Middle Earth was taken up by J.R.R Tolkien in Lord of the Rings. Maybe he caught something of the ancient power of Whitby.

So, we head back to the museum and visitor centre and café. It looks like quite a feat: there's an interactive guide, an exhibition and even a signed copy of Bram Stoker's great masterpiece. Plus, of course, there are other ancient artefacts and illuminated books. History is piled up in layers here. The Abbey (ruined under Henry V111's dissolution of the monasteries some time after 1536) is built over the earlier monastery community of Hilda. Museums can be a mixed blessing. They have a narrative, and visitors to entertain and educate. Sometimes the story is told with too many straight lines. There's a temptation to rush to the shop or take a selfie and not really get what the place is about. Michael Carter, senior historian at English Heritage, understands: 'I want people to come away excited, to understand the kinds of life that were lived here. Those lives are just as relevant today, they still speak to our deep needs.' Michael has a story of his own: 'When I was a boy I used to visit the great monasteries in the north-east. I found them places of wonder. They touched my soul and they stir me to this day.'

The ancient Celts had a phrase they used, 'thin places.' That is, areas where you fell closer to that particular energy that seems to drive the universe. These are places of encounter, places we can lose ourselves in. The down to earth little Yorkshire town of Whitby is just such a 'thin place.' Is the museum big enough for the story it has to tell? Can it capture the unique magic of the place?

It faces a great challenge, to leave room for something altogether more ancient, dangerous and beautiful. To grasp the wonder of Whitby and its abbey and saints, English Heritage understands, will take more than a good gift shop.

Whitby Abbey's museum is open every day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.



Giving up drinking has helped me to understand myself.

Nick's denial that he was an alcoholic, held him back for many years. An ultimatum got him to try Alcoholics Anonymous again. Now his relationships are better, and he understands himself more. Read his story here.

"I am 58 years old and retired; married with two grown up children. I don't come from a family of big drinkers. There was alcohol around as I was growing up, but it was never an issue for other family members.

I am dyslexic, and when I was at school it wasn't a recognised condition. I think this led, in part, to me feeling different. I had low self-esteem and very little confidence in myself. At 14 years old, when I first tried drinking, all that changed. The alcohol made me feel great about myself, and I no longer felt different.

My drinking was a problem for many years, and it got worse after the breakdown of my first marriage. It also led to me not being around for my kids, in the way that I wanted to be. Which I carry a lot of guilt over. I first tried Alcoholics Anonymous in my 30s, but I didn't stick it out, I went a couple of times and then just carried on drinking.

As I got older, my alcohol use increased. The relationship I had with my children wasn't good, and my second wife and I were arguing constantly. Eventually she said if I carried on drinking the way I was, the marriage was over.

This got me to AA a second time. I went along weekly to meetings, but I was still in denial that I was an alcoholic. I was just giving up the booze for my wife, not for me. As a result, I didn't really get involved in the fellowship, work the 12-steps, or commit to the program, in any way. Deep down, I knew that I had a problem, but my denial held me back. Then I was at the airport, and I drank ³/₄ of a bottle of brandy. That was the moment I realised; I had no control over alcohol. This got me back to the meetings, with a renewed vigour.

I now go to 3-4 meetings a week. I have changed my routines, and the places I go. I stopped hanging around with the people I drank with. I have told close friends I am an alcoholic and that I have stopped drinking, so they don't offer me drinks. I have found new hobbies and activities to occupy my time. I help others, I do some charity work. And a day at a time, life has got better.

To anyone who is struggling I would say, if you want a better life without alcohol, just try. Don't believe all the rumours and misconceptions – AA is a spiritual program that you just need to be open-minded to.

Never-say-never. I didn't think I could do it; and my journey is just beginning. My life is so much better now. No hangovers. I am of service to others, in and outside of the fellowship. I have a better relationship with my daughters, my wife. I understand myself much more."

There are meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous, with friendly people who will understand, held daily, throughout the Costa del Sol. Meetings are free to attend, and anyone who thinks they may have a problem with alcohol is welcome.






